All attend staff training and learn valuable information that will assist them in their area of ministry such as: presenting Bible studies/Bunkhouse Devotions, building relationships, soul winning, horse safety, wrangling skills, mechanics behind media and other skills that help them minister to children. Upon satisfactory completion of staff training, each will be assigned to work two weeks of camp in their area of ministry.

**Counselor In-Trainings (CIT)** will assist counselors with bunkhouse activities and help teach games, sports and lead Bible studies/Bunkhouse Devotions.

**Barn In-Trainings (BIT)** will assist the wranglers in chores, saddling horses, trail rides, and other horse-related projects.
